READY FOR SPRING!!

I would like to thank you for your patronage and hope you and your horses are well!

Planning a vacation or going out of town? We hope that you might take advantage of our turn-out options while you are gone. If you'd like to get away and know that your horse is getting some playtime as well, schedule turn out time for them! This is a great way to get them out while you are gone, so they aren't as frisky when you return! Perhaps you aren't getting to them as much as you'd like to, we all have busy schedules. DETC has monthly turn-out and exercise options available! \$40 can get your horse out of its stall and into the turn out twice a week for the month, grooming and hoof care included! Ask Darcy for more details...

Rain has finally shown its ugly head... Be sure to keep an eye on your horse's feet, whether they are in the barn or in an outside corral. Thrush is a fungus that can grow in the frog of the hoof, and is usually black until picked with a hoof-pick and then you will see white. To aid your horse in staying sound, you might spray the bottom of his or her feet with a 50-50 mix of bleach and water, or invest in some betadine to pour on it as well.

If you have purchased a blanket to help keep you horse warm and clean this winter, our on-site managers can blanket and unblanket for you. Checks can be made directly to Darcy Edwards for \$30 (blanket put on and taken off)

ECLAP Vet News and Updates

ECEC shot clinics are still held on Saturdays, approximately at 8 a.m. with Dr. May or Dr. White of El Cajon Valley Vet Hospital. They will be here then to provide shots as needed, to check teeth, or anything else your horse might need.

If your horse requires something above a routine shot or health "look-over", please contact their office and let them know ahead of time, so they may plan their day better. The office number is 619-444-9340

DETC uses the vets of East County Large Animal Practice for their horse's routine maintenance. Most DETC horses are due for

spring shots in March. This includes the 4-way and Rhino vaccines, as well as the West Nile. For horses that travel to shows, Strangles is also recommended but not required.

The West Nile vaccine should be given every 6 months. The threat of West Nile is still here in Lakeside!

ECLAP Programs from page 2**PREVENTICARE**

This plan provides you with the best possible preventative health care. Also, under a special agreement with Pfizer Animal Health, the makers of Strongid C2X, if your horse colics while enrolled in the PreventiCare plan and requires surgery, Pfizer will reimburse you for the cost of the surgery plus up to three days of aftercare up to \$5,000.00! This colic assistance is provided at no additional charge when you enroll in, and comply with the terms of the program.

To qualify, the patient must receive the following services from ECLAP:

- Annual physical exam and nutritional consultation
- Annual dental examination/care
- Recommended vaccination regimen
- Twice-yearly purge worming with Ivermectin
- Daily use of Strongid C2X purchased from ECLAP

The following is a description of the actual cost of the PreventiCare health program which supports you in complying with the above:

Twice-yearly examinations: \$66.00 x 2= \$132.00
 Annual 5-Way vaccination: \$47.00 x 1= \$47.00
 Six month Booster flu/rhino vaccination: \$30.00 x 1= \$30.00
 Annual teeth float and sedation \$124.00 x 1= \$124.00
 Twice-yearly worming with ivermectin \$21.00 x 2= \$42.00
 First bucket of Strongid C2x \$45.00 x 1= \$45.00
 Bi-Annual West Nile Virus vaccination \$32.00 x 2= \$64.00
 Total= \$484.00
 Your cost to enroll in the PreventiCare plan is \$370.00

Ranch Calls and any additional procedures are not included and are regularly priced. Plan Participants MUST purchase Strongid C2X from ECLAP. This is a requirement from Pfizer to prove that your horse is on the daily wormer. Strangles vaccinations are not included in the plan; it is available for an additional fee.

There are only three (3) disqualifications for the PreventiCare program. These horses are not eligible for reimbursement on colic surgery.

1. Any horse that has had prior colic surgery
2. Any horse that has experienced colic in the past 12 months/ has a history of chronic colic
3. Any horse that is under 5 months of age and not fully weaned from its mother, or any horse older than 20 years of age (Horses that are enrolled before the age of 20 may re-enroll each year until age 2. If enrollment lapses at anytime after the age of 20, the horse will not be eligible for re-enrollment.).

HEALTH MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

ECLAP has a yearly program that condenses the amount of doctor visits for annual procedures. Every year a horse should receive vaccinations, teeth floating, deworming and sheath cleaning. The HMP is a program that will provide you with all of these services.

A one-time fee of \$360.00 is paid on the first visit and includes: 1) twice yearly ranch calls and physical exams, 2) twice yearly vaccinations (one 5-way, one Flu Rhino, and twice Yearly West Nile Virus Vaccinations), 3) six dewormers, 4) teeth examined and floated with sedation, and 5) sheath cleaned and examined. The price does stay the same if the horse is a mare and does not need a sheath cleaning. The price does go down if you have more than one horse on the program. For two or more horses, it is \$330.00 per horse. Strangles vaccinations are not included in the program and are an additional fee.

The average cost of services for the year is:

When the doctor comes out to perform these appointments he/she will leave a six month supply of dewormers to last until the next appointment. This program is a wonderful way to lessen the amount of doctor visits. Also, with this program there is an average cost of over 50% savings.
