Here comes warmer weather...

It's a great thing that we at El Capitan are lucky enough to have lights in the arenas! Warmer, well, HOT, weather started early for us this year, which will make riding during daytime hours nearly impossible...

Please keep an eye on your four-legged friends! Dehydration is probably the number one cause of colic, and the heat will not help! Checking to make sure your horse has a working water is always a good idea. Barn managers Jason and Cheryl will also make sure their waters stay clean. What can you do to help your horse? First, if you do ride when it's hot, take longer to warm up and cool off your horse. Also, rinsing your horse is a nice treat, but make sure he or she is at least partially dry before they go back to their stalls. Horses can develop a second sweat or cramping when it's hot out, and we don't want that!

Electrolytes are a wonderful way to make sure your horse drinks enough water too. You can get them a mix that is like salt to put in their feed, or you can purchase a paste electrolyte from a local feed store!

The heat couldn't deter our show team from attending the Poway Open show on April 26. Hannah, Mo, Sophie, Larissa and Sandy all made the trip up the hill for some fun in the sun. My Poway girls made the trip too and it was fun to see Mozey do well with Haley, and Kourtney and Kelsey made their show debut! The next

Vet News and Updates

ECEC shot clinics are held on Saturdays, approximately at 8 a.m. with Dr. May or Dr. White of El Cajon Valley Vet Hospital. They will be here then to provide shots as needed, to check teeth, or anything else your horse might need.

If your horse requires something above a routine shot or health "look-over", please contact their office and let them know ahead of time, so they may plan their day better. The office number is 619-444-9340

El Capitan Equestrian Center requires that we have all horses current

with vaccines and immunization records. Please make sure that your horse is up to date, and that ECEC has a record of such. We don't want our horses in danger of anything!

The West Nile vaccine should be given every 6 months. The threat of West Nile is still here in Lakeside!

Spring time is a good time to have your horse's teeth checked! Horse teeth should be floated once a year, when was the last time your horse visited the dentist???

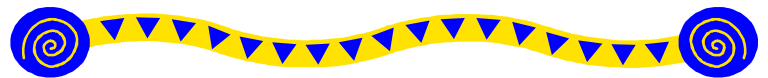
